Tarros line calls Setúbal in a weekly standard



The Tarros Line will have one more vessel in the “Great Pendulum Service” Regular Line Service at the Port of Setúbal, from the end of September. The M/V “Natalia A”, of the Arkas Line, will belong to this service, being four the vessels assigned to this line.

Thus, will belong to the line the vessels “Vento di Zefiro”, “Vento di Tramontana”, “Vento di Nortada” and, from September, the “Natalia A”, which is represented at the Port of Setúbal by Atlantic-Lusofrete.

This collaboration, which involves the space sharing on board between the Tarros Line and Arkas Line, will allow, besides a weekly frequency at the Port of Setúbal instead of the previous thirteen days, a cooperation with the Arkas Line “Levante” Service, which connects Turkey to Egypt, to Syria and Lebanon, meaning that the Port of Setúbal will be connected to Beirut, in Lebanon, by transshipment at Istanbul, in Turkey.

The service offered with transshipment includes also the connections to the ports of Gemlik, Gebze and Izmir, in Turkey; Alger, Oran and Annaba, in Algeria; Trapani, in Italy; Lattakia, in Syria; Odessa, in Ukraine; Novorossik, in Russia and, yet, services to Malta and Tunisia.

Remind that Tarros Line connects regularly and without transshipment, eastbound, from the Port of Setúbal, the ports of La Spezia and Salerno, in Italy; Piraeus and Salónica, in Greece; Istanbul and Mersin, in Turkey, and, west, from Mersin, the ports of Alexandria, in Egypt; Naples and La Spezia, in Italy; Casablanca, in Marrocos, and Setúbal.
